**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES:**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the NWISA District Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.
- 1.3. Under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied.

**2. ELIGIBILITY:**

- 2.1. This is a 'Ranking Regatta' as described in the NWISA District Rules. 'Active' teams may attend. There will only be one "Gold" fleet. Mixed teams will not be permitted.
- 2.2. Competing 'Gold' teams shall be members of NWISA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules (unless modified by District Rule 4.2).
- 2.3. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 4 sailors. Only one team per school is allowed in 'Gold' fleet.
- 2.4. Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.5. The top SEVEN teams not previously qualified, will qualify for a berth at the NWISA Fleet Race Championship per District Rule 6.2

**3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE:**

- 3.1. Eligible schools shall register through the NWISA website link. Registration is on a first come, first served if berths are limited. Registration opens Monday March 11, 2019 at 1100.
- 3.2. Registration closes Monday March 18, 2019 at 2200. Additional registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if event capacity is reached.
- 3.3. Teams unable to compete once registration closes, shall notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
- 3.4. Each competitor must have a signed WAIVER OF LIABILITY/RELEASE OF RISK on file (ATTACHED).
- 3.5. An entry fee of \$20 per sailor payable to: "OHYS" will be collected at check in (programs bringing multiple teams must pay per team).
- 3.6. Each competing program must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA per District rule 7.3.

**4. BOATS:**

- 4.1 Races will be sailed in FJ's.
- 4.2 Host has 4 FJ's, teams are asked to bring 17 additional FJ's.

## 6. RACING AREA:

All races will be sailed West of Oak Harbor Marina breakwater. Boat rotations will occur from OHM breakwater.

## 7. COURSES:

Short collegiate style races in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

## 8. SCORING:

The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

## 9. HOUSING:

- 9.1. Oak Harbor High School Gym is available to all competitors Saturday night at 8:00 pm and closes Sunday morning at 8:00 am. **Sailors MUST be supervised/chaperoned by responsible adult at all times while on school campus.** Teams are responsible for providing their own supervision and bedding. Teams shall be responsible to clean up after themselves.
- 9.2. Please rsvp for your overnight stay on district registration spreadsheet.

## 10. FOOD:

- 10.1 Sailors need to bring lunch and snacks for Saturday.
- 10.2 Oak Harbor Yacht Club will serve dinner Saturday night.
- 10.3 Oak Harbor Yacht Club will serve breakfast Sunday morning.
- 10.4 Sailors will make their own lunches at Oak Harbor Yacht Club Sunday morning during breakfast.
- 10.5 Sailors are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle.

## 11. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:

## 12. COACHING:

- 12.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday morning to the end of racing Sunday unless an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.
- 12.2. Competitors may receive coaching including instructions, assistance, equipment or sustenance only while on the designated rotation float or on shore.

## 13. CONDUCT:

- 13.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.
- 13.2. Infringements of this regulation and/or other inappropriate conduct occurring during the regatta, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall, at a time and place selected by it, meet to hear said protest, and it may impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions that it deems appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta.
