



**San Juan Islands Regional Team Race
March 16th, 2019
Westsound, Orcas Island, WA**

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, including Appendix D, the ISSA Procedural Rules, and the NWISA District Rules.
2. Limited umpiring will be used (see rule D2.6 in Appendix D).
3. The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

1. Competing schools shall be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
2. Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
3. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 6 sailors. Multiple teams per school are allowed (limited by boat availability). Teams with less than 6 sailors should contact the regatta chair for help combining with another school.
4. Team must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA.

3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE:

1. Eligible schools shall register at nwisa.hssailing.org. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. Registration opens March 3rd at 1100. Registration closes March 11th at 2200. Boats will be allocated at this time. Additional registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if boats are unavailable.
2. Teams unable to compete after registration closes shall notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
3. There is no entry fee. Snacks and hot drinks may be provided.

4. BOATS:

1. Sail Orcas, San Juan Island Sailing Foundation will provide FJs. Traveling teams are encouraged to bring FJs to finalize a third flight.

5. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, March 16, 2019

0740 - 0830 Ferry to Orcas Island.
0845 – 0930 Launch boats at Orcas Island Yacht Club.
0930 Mandatory Competitors Meeting at Port Plaza.
1000 First warning; sailing will continue throughout the day.
1700 No starts after this time.
1820 - 1940 Ferry to Mainland

6. LAUNCHING AREA:

Teams bringing boats are to launch them at Orcas Island Yacht Club dock.

7. RACING AREA:

Racing will take place in Westsound.

8. COACHING:

1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday morning to the end of racing Sunday unless an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.
2. We will have 1 additional/back-up safety launch at the dock. This may be used for Coaches to informally umpire if feasible, and for the benefit of all sailors.

9. CONDUCT

1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.
2. Infringements of this regulation and/or other inappropriate conduct occurring during the regatta, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall, at a time and place selected by it, meet to hear said protest, and it may impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions that it deems appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta.
