NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, including Appendix D, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Limited umpiring will be used (see rule D2.6 in Appendix D).
- 1.3. The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.
- 1.4. Under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. This event is open to all NWISA teams, but is organized for and targeted towards high school sailors in the 'Seattle' region of NWISA.
- 2.2. This is an Open Regatta as defined by the NWISA District Supplemental Rules, mixed teams are allowed.
- 2.3. Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.

3. ENTRY:

- 3.1. Eligible schools shall register through the NWISA website link. <u>Registration opens</u> September 30th, 2019 at 1100.
- 3.2. <u>Registration closes</u> October 7th, 2019 at 2200. Additional registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if event capacity is reached.
- 3.3. Teams unable to compete once boats once registration closes, shall notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
- 3.4. Each competitor must have a signed <u>2019 SSP Regatta Participant Waiver</u> on file (attached). Participants that completed these forms for the SSP Combined Division Regatta do not need to resubmit this waiver.
- 3.5. No entry fee, bring your own lunch.

4. BOATS:

- 4.1. SSP will provide 2 sets of 6 FJs.
- 4.2. Teams will be asked to bring additional FJs and sails to complete the fleet.

5. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, October 12, 2019

Any changes to the schedule will be posted on the Official Notice Board located on the Sail Sand Point pier.

6. RACING AREA:

All races will be sailed on Lake Washington, in the waters off Sail Sand Point. Boat swaps will occur from the Sand Point pier and harbor.

7. COURSES:

A digital 'N' course will be set.

8. SCORING:

The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. FORMAT:

A single round robin will be attempted. If time allows a top four round will be sailed.

10. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:

11. COACHING:

Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday morning to the end of racing Sunday unless an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

12. CONDUCT:

- 12.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.
- 12.2. Infringements of this regulation and/or other inappropriate conduct occurring during the regatta, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall, at a time and place selected by it, meet to hear said protest, and it may impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions that it deems appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta.
