NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017–2020, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the NWISA District Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.
- 1.3. Under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. This is an 'Open Regatta' as described in the NWISA District Rules. 'Active' and 'Mixed' teams may attend.
- 2.2. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 4 sailors. Multiple teams per school are allowed (limited by boat availability).
- 2.3. Full Teams and mixed teams are allowed and will sail together in Collegiate Rigged 420's
- 2.4. Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.

3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE:

- 3.1. Eligible schools shall register through the NWISA website link. Registration is on a first come, first served if berths are limited. Registration opens 2/18/19 at 1100.
- 3.2. Registration closes 2/25/19 at 2200. Additional registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if event capacity is reached.
- 3.3. Teams unable to compete once registration closes, shall notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
- 3.4. Each competitor must have a signed on file (attached below).
- 3.5. An entry fee of \$10.00 payable to: "Willamette Sailing Club" per sailor will be collected at check in.
- 3.6. Each competing program must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA per District rule 7.3.

4. BOATS AND FORMAT:

- 4.1. This regatta will be sailed in C420's (without trapeze and spinnaker). WSC has 12 boats available for charter. Once 12 teams have signed up, remaining teams will be responsible for bringing one 420 per team.

5. RACING AREA:

5.1. All races will be sailed on the Willamette River just to the east of the docks. Boat rotations will occur from the docks to the east and south of the sailing facility.

6. COURSES:

6.1. Short collegiate style races in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

7. SCORING:

7.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

8. HOUSING:

8.1. No housing will be provided

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:

Teams are responsible for their own transportation. The address of the regatta site is: Willamette Sailing Club, 6336 SW Beaver Ave. Portland OR, 97239.

9. COACHING:

9.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday morning to the end of racing Sunday unless an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

9.2. Competitors may receive coaching including instructions, assistance, equipment or sustenance only while on the designated rotation float or on shore.

10. CONDUCT:

10.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.

10.2. Infringements of this regulation and/or other inappropriate conduct occurring during the regatta, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall, at a time and place selected by it, meet to hear said protest, and it may impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions that it deems appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta.
