Organizing Authority: The Richmond Yacht Club (RYC) and Marina Bay are the organizing authorities, in conjunction with PCISA and the NorCal league.

****Note****

- Car parking in the lot is \$10 a day. FREE parking out on the street in front (suggested)
- Safety and Coach boats can be launched at Marina Bay and trailers can be stored there overnight
- [All safety/coach boats will be stored at RYC overnight](#)
- There will be a marked off area for trailer and FJ storage.

FACILITIES AND LAUNCHING WILL BE VERY SIMILAR TO THOSE AT PYSF

Rules: The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, as modified by the current ISSA and PCISA Procedural Rules, the *new* "Notice of Regattas" for the 2015-2016 NorCal One-Day Regattas, and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility and Format:

- **Teams must be registered and paid in full with PCISA before the event**
- Each team must consist of two sailors who attend the same school, except for the following exceptions: one "borrowed sailor" is allowed for teams with 3 or fewer sailors on their official PCISA roster. Any borrowed sailor must be a registered member of a NorCal high school team.
- 8th grade students attending a feeder school to the high school may sail, however a maximum of one 8th grader is allowed to sail in any boat.
- Sailors who have skippered a boat in the Gold Fleet at more than one PCISA district-wide regatta within the year prior to each NorCal One Day Regatta are NOT ELIGIBLE to participate as a skipper in that NorCal One Day Regatta.
- There is no limit on substitutions within a team, although after competing as a skipper an individual shall not sail for another team in either division.
- Each team must provide their own class legal CFJ, including sails with distinct NorCal assigned sail number and all rigging. Boats will not be rotated.
- Coaching on the water is permitted between races.
- There will be storage in the RYC small boat yard for boats on Saturday evening.

Entry & Registration

- For NorCal #1 and #2 schools may enter up to the following maximum number of boats:
- Up to 12 sailors on PCISA roster = 2 boats
- 13-20 sailors on PCISA roster = 4 boats
- 21-29 sailors on PCISA roster = 6 boats
- 30 or more sailors on PCISA roster = 8 boats
- Register for NorCal #1 and/or NorCal #2 online via the PCISA website

Please Note:

Registration open at 5:00pm on September 5th, 2017

Registration closes at 5:00pm on Friday, 22nd, 2017

- Each boat must enter in either Gold or Silver fleet, including sailor names
- Each boat must enter with one of their pre-assigned NorCal sail numbers
- Teams shall load sailor names into **TechScore by 5:00 pm, Saturday September 23rd, 2017.**

Nor Cal One- Day regatta capacity is 60 boats total (30/30 Gold and Silver Fleets). In the event that a regatta is oversubscribed at the registration deadline, entries will be declined in the following order until 60 or fewer teams are entered. Entries being declined will be notified by email as soon as possible by the BAYS NorCal Allocation Subcommittee.

- Boats using a borrowed sailor.
- One boat from teams with large rosters (13 or more sailors), in descending order of size.
- Boats using 8th graders
- One boat from teams with large rosters. This step will be repeated until the required number of boats is reached.

Fees

- The **Entry Fee** for NorCal #1 and #2 is \$25.00 per competitor, per regatta. The fee includes awards.
