1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA), the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING (US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4 are deleted); the rules of the Laser/Radial Class (except as altered by the Sailing Instructions, or ISSA/PCISA); and by the Sailing Instructions. In accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 20(b) the right of appeal is denied at all District Championships. Decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.

3. FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY

The event will be sailed in two fleets Full Rig and Radial. Properly registered (2018-19 ISSA/PCISA) teams may enter as many eligible competitors in each fleet as desired. Boys and girls may enter and compete in either fleet.

4. BOATS & SAILS

Each team entered is responsible for providing one complete class legal Laser or Radial for each competitor. Competitors will sail the same boat for the entire regatta. No boat rotations.

6. SKIPPERS' MEETING, SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & CHECK IN

All teams must check in at the registration table at the SFYC Youth Picnic Area first thing Saturday morning. There will be a skippers' meeting at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, September 22nd at the Youth Picnic Area. Sailing Instructions will be available at the check in table. Check in will begin at 0900.

7. ENTRY & FEES

The Entry Fee is \$50.00 per competitor and is due with online registration by 5pm on September 14, 2018. The online entry form must be completed by 5pm (PDT) on September 14, 2018. Entry fees must be paid in full with the online entry and by the deadline. Online entry is available at <u>www.pcisa.org</u>.

8. SAILING AREA/LAUNCHING

The sailing area for all fleets will be the Southampton Shoals/North Berkeley Circle area, approximately 30 minutes by tow from SFYC. All boats must launch and be stored overnight on Saturday at SFYC.

9. COACHBOATS

Coachboats must be shared. SFYC will have some boats available for coaches, but some coaches should bring boats as well and must add them to the list to be shared. To obtain a spot on a coach boat (including coaches bringing coachboats) coaches MUST register by emailing <u>forrest@sfyc.org</u> by 1700 on Friday September 14, 2018. Coaches that plan to bring coachboats should notify Forrest of such when registering as a coach as above.

10. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to teams/competitors qualifying for ISSA Single-handed Nationals. This is: Top 3 Finishers in Full Rig and Radials

11. PARKING
