1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Interscholastic Sailing Association (PCISA), together with Richmond Yacht Club.

2 RULES

- 2.1 The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by the current ISSA and PCISA Procedural Rules, the Notice of Series, this Notice of Race for each Event, and the Sailing Instructions for each regatta.
- 2.2 Trailer parking will be in the front parking lot, North of the yacht club. NO PARKING IN THE DIRT LOT OF ANY KIND.
- 2.3 Safety and Coach boat trailers will also need to be stored in the north parking lot.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND FORMAT

Eligibility is governed by the NorCal One-Day Notice of Series.

4 ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

- 4.1 Entry and Registration is governed by the NorCal One-Day Notice of Series.
- 4.2 These two regattas have a maximum of 60 entries each. If there are more than 60 entries, PCISA will decline entries in the following order: Teams using borrowed sailors; and then one team from each school with the largest number of entries, repeated until the total number of entries is below 60. Teams will be notified of their entry status as soon as possible after the entry deadline.

5 FEES

Fees are governed by the NorCal One-Day Notice of Series. Lunch is not provided. Please bring your own lunch.

COVID-19 Information: Richmond Yacht Club has required all competitors, and others attending to be fully vaccinated at its recent open regattas. Assuming RYC elects to require vaccinations for this regatta, each coach will be required to confirm prior to the regatta that all members of their team, support persons and others attending are fully vaccinated. The only exceptions will be for persons under the minimum vaccination age of 12, and those with written medical or religious exemptions issued by a licensed health provider or established religious organization. In the unlikely event that RYC does not require vaccination for this regatta, notice will be posted on the PCISA website.
