1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Interscholastic Sailing Association (PCISA), together with Encinal Yacht Club.

2 RULES

2.1 The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by the current ISSA and PCISA Procedural Rules, the Notice of Series, this Notice of Race for each Event, and the Sailing Instructions for each regatta.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND FORMAT

Eligibility is governed by the NorCal One-Day Notice of Series.

4 ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

4.1 Entry and Registration is governed by the NorCal One-Day Notice of Series.

4.2 These two regattas have a maximum of 60 entries each. If there are more than 60 entries, PCISA will decline entries in the following order: Teams using borrowed sailors; and then one team from each school with the largest number of entries, repeated until the total number of entries is below 60. Teams will be notified of their entry status as soon as possible after the entry deadline.
