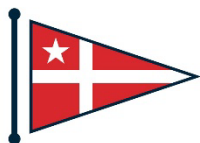

Notice of Race

The Organizing Authority: The Pacific Coast Interscholastic Sailing Association (PCISA)

The Host(s): The Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC)



1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the ISSA Procedural Rules as modified by the PCISA District Rules.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P shall apply as modified by the ISSA procedural rules.
- 1.3 The US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 63.2 shall not apply.

2 ENTRY & ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 A team may enter by submitting an online entry form available at:

- 2.2 **All entries must be paid and received by 1700 hours Friday, April 18, 2025.**
- 2.3 Eligibility and selection to this event shall be determined by the guidelines of the PCISA and the ISSA. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the ISSA Procedural Rule. Entrants are reminded that 8th-grade students or 'borrowed sailors' are not permitted at this event and that sailors who compete in the 2025 PCISA Silver Championships are NOT eligible for the Gold Championships. Selection of competing schools will be done by the PCISA Board or its designated committee. The PCISA Board has final authority over berth allocations to this regatta.

3 FEES

An entry fee of \$400.00 per team will be required to complete registration. This fee includes boats, sails, after racing snacks, and 4 shirts for each team. Extra shirts may be purchased during online registration only for \$25 each. Additional shirts will not be available for purchase on the day of the regatta.

4 FORMAT

The regatta will be sailed in a round robin rotation which will be detailed at scores.hssailing.org. Each team will have an A division and a B division.

5 BOATS

Each team will be provided one complete class legal CFJ and PCISA set of sails. OA provided equipment shall be used.

7 CHECK IN, BOAT INSPECTION, AND SAIL ASSIGNMENTS

The registration table will open at 0915 hours on the beach next to the launch ramp. Teams must first check in to receive boat & sail assignments as well as regatta shirts.

8 BERTHING – BOAT, TRAILER, AND DOLLY STORAGE

- 8.1 Boats and dollies will be stored in the launch ramp parking lot and the UCSB sailing dock in designated areas during the event.
- 8.2 Teams may not use the launch ramp or adjacent docks for rigging or boat storage.

9 PARKING - VEHICLES

Parents and participants should comply with all parking regulations and will be responsible for any parking fees. Boats, dollies, or cars should not impede traffic in the launch ramp area for any reason. Boats should not be left at the launch ramp dock, except when actively launching or retrieving for the day. Failure to comply with these policies may result in citations for vehicles. This rule is not protestable.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Boats should be launched from the east most launch ramp dock. Competitors are advised that the ramps may be slippery during low tide.

11 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions and boat rotations will be available at <https://scores.hssailing.org>.

12 SAILING AREA

The sailing area will be the Santa Barbara Channel within one half mile of the harbor entrance. Further description will be given at the competitor meeting. The rotation area will be announced at the competitor meeting.

13 VENUE AND LODGING

- 13.1 The venue is located at the Santa Barbara Harbor Launch Ramp. It is located adjacent to the UCSB Sailing Facility near the intersection of West Cabrillo Boulevard and Bath Street. To enter the SB Harbor parking lot, go to 'Harbor Way' in Santa Barbara, California and turn into the gated public parking lot. Continue through the parking lot until you see the launch ramps. Or google map 'Boat Launch Mini Mart, 305 W Cabrillo Blvd, Santa Barbara, CA 93101' and follow those directions.
- 13.2 There are several hotels on Cabrillo Blvd. within walking distance of the regatta site. Early reservations are usually necessary. More affordable options are also available in Santa Barbara or Goleta with a 15-minute drive. SBYC & UCSB recommend that hotel reservations be made as far in advance as possible. 14 FOOD & DRINKING WATER

There will be a drinking water refill station at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club, however large jugs of water are encouraged as it is a five-minute walk from the rotation area to the refill station. There will not be food at the rotation site and teams should plan accordingly.

15 SCORING

The regatta shall be scored in accordance with ISSA and PCISA Procedural rules.

16 COACHES AND SPECTATORS

Coaching shall occur in accordance with ISSA and PCISA Procedural rules and shall not occur on the water.

17 PARTICIPATION

With the exception of RRS Rule 3, each school shall compete in all scheduled races. Any school breaking this rule without permission of the Race Committee is subject to severe disciplinary actions by the PCISA.

18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

19 SAFETY AND ADULT RESPONSIBILITY

An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of each sailor. It is the sole responsibility of this adult to decide if the sailor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adults supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. Parents not personally attending any part of the event shall ensure that another adult is authorized and designated to make these decisions for their sailor.
