ISSA Cressy Single-handed Nationals 2022-23

The ISSA Board of Directors has made some changes to the 2022-23 ISSA Cressy Single-handed Nationals Championships. Thanks to the new Sponsorship arrangement with Zim and West Coast Sailing ISSA will be providing 36 sets of new ILCA Sails (18 ILCA 6 & 18 ILCA 7) and they will be providing up to 24 ILCA complete boats for charter. With the target fleet sizes of 18 ILCA 6's and 18 ILCA 7's (36 Total) this will require 12 competitors to bring or charter boats independently.

We are also seeing low registration for the ILCA 7 (Full Rig) District Championship. Because of these changes and the registration numbers the following amendment to the Notice of Race for the PCISA Single-handed District Championships on September 24-25, 2022, at PCSF in Redwood City, CA is being issued:

3. FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY

All text from NOR Item #3 in the original NOR is deleted and replaced with the following:

The event will be sailed in one fleet ILCA 6 (Radial). Properly registered (2022-23 ISSA/PCISA) teams may enter as many eligible competitors as desired. Boys and girls are eligible.

11. TROPHIES & NATIONALS BERTHS

All text from NOR Item #11 in the original NOR is deleted and replaced with the following:

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishing teams/competitors in this regatta.

Berths to the 2022-23 ISSA Cressy National Championships will be assigned by the PCISA Board of Directors. Berths in the ILCA 6 (Radial) Fleet will be assigned in the order of finish from the PCISA District Championships. PCISA berths to the ILCA 7 (Full Rig) Fleet will be assigned by the PCISA Board using the results from the District Championships as well as other factors (i.e., Resume, Body Size, etc.) to select representatives. ONLY competitors in the 2022 PCISA District Single-handed Championships will be considered for berths to the National Championships. Not all berths (ILCA 7 – Full Rig) may be assigned at the discretion of the PCISA Board. An application for the ILCA 7 – Full Rig berths will be distributed to all 2022 PCISA Single-Handed District Championships Radial Fleet Competitors following the District Championships.
