# SAISA Lake Crabtree Open 11<sup>th</sup> November 2017

## **NOTICE OF RACE**

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with RTP High School Sailing Program & The Carolina Sailing Foundation

SITE: Lake Crabtree, 1400 Aviation Parkway, Morrisville, NC 27560

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the 2016 SAISA Supplemental Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions, the latter shall take precedence.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P is in effect modified per ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c).
- 1.3. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) in conjunction with the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) and the RTP High School Sailing Program and the Carolina Sailing Foundation.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Competing schools must be current members of ISSA and SAISA and meet eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, and Supplemental Rules.
- 2.2. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school. The team leader must have the authority to authorize medical care for all sailors on their team.

# 3. FORMAT

- 3.1. This will be a two-division regatta. Teams will rotate per a rotation chart distributed at the Competitor's Meeting or they will be posted online at techscore for this event.
- 3.2. Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a regatta.

#### 4. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

- 4.1. Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting an official entry form and check with the regatta chairperson by Wednesday, November 8th, 2017. Send all forms and checks to: Howard Ferguson, 210 Shadow Hawk Drive, Durham, NC 27713.

- 4.3. Registration will be confirmed via mail or phone, if email is not available.
- 4.4. Split teams, composite teams and Junior Varsity teams are permitted to register per SAISA Supplemental Rules.

# 5. ENTRY FEE:

- 5.1. The entry is \$60.00 per team. This includes up to 5 lunches, snacks, bottled water and drinks. Lunch donation of \$5 for team leaders, coaches and parents. Vegetarian options provided.
- 5.2. Reservations for all lunches MUST BE MADE with registration.
- 5.3. Make checks payable to: Carolina Sailing Foundation

#### 6. DAMAGE DEPOSIT:

- 6.1. A damage deposit of \$100 must be submitted with each entry. Actual cost of damage repairs will be charged which may exceed the \$100 deposit. This deposit is refundable if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.
- 6.2. Make checks payable to: Carolina Sailing Foundation

#### 7. BOATS:

- 7.1. The host will provide Eight (8) boats.
- 7.2. Teams which register after the total number of provided boats has been allocated will be required to provide a boat and sails of comparable condition to be entered into the rotation.
- 7.3. As per SAISA Supplemental Rule 4.5.1., boat assignments will be based upon the order that registration is received for Full, Split and Composite team. If a team also registers a JV team, boats will be assigned after the Full, Split and Composite teams have been assigned boats.

#### 8. SCHEDULE:

8.2. Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board located at the Boat Rental Center at Lake Crabtree

#### 9. RACING AREA:

9.1. All races will be sailed on Lake Crabtree in front of the Boat Rental Center.

#### 10. COURSES:

10.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

#### 11. SCORING:

11.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules and SAISA Supplemental Rules.

## 12. DIRECTIONS:

12.1. Lake Crabtree (1400 Aviation Parkway, Morrisville, NC 27560) is located just south of RDU airport. From I-40 take exit 285 heading south for about ¼ of a mile. The entrance to Lake Crabtree is the first left south of I-40. # 13. HOUSING:

13.1. There are numerous hotels near RDU airport within a 15 minute drive to the sailing venue.

#### 14. COACHING:

14.1. Coaches shall not go afloat in the sailing area during racing unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson.

#### **15. OFFICIAL NOTICE:**

15.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(b). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.

#### 16. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:

16.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

#### 17. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

- 17.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 17.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

# **18. SAFETY:**

- 18.1. Competitors shall wear USCG approved Type III lifejackets. Inflatable type lifejackets are not permitted.
- 18.2. A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee either before leaving the course, or if that is impossible, immediately after arriving ashore.
