Competitors, families, and friends,

We are excited to be hosting a South Points regatta again this year and are looking forward to a great day of sailing. The Davis Island Yacht Club is a generous host, and we are grateful that they allow us to hold the event at the Club each year. There are a few house rules that will help make the day run smoothly.

Regatta and COVID Protocols at DIYC –

- NO spectators (this includes chaperones, parents, and reciprocal members) will be allowed inside the Club or on the upper porches for viewing or dining. Please inform your parents so we do not have any issues on regatta day.
- Teams should not arrive prior to 0730 am.
- If you plan to drop a trailer off on Friday, you must contact the Club office in advance to find out where you can park.
- We ask that you limit the number of chaperones to two per registered team (V and JV are two teams) as we do not have space for parking inside the gates of the Club if you are not a tow vehicle.
- Reciprocal members are welcome to use the takeout window on the North Porch at the top of the stairs to order drinks.
- Due to COVID-19 protocols at the Club, **camping is not available this year.**

Parking – DIYC is hosting the Hillsborough Bay Race on Saturday with adult competitors arriving around 11am. Parking will be at a premium, so we ask that you follow directions given by the police officer or volunteer at the main gate. One trailer and one car per registered team will be able to park on the grass inside the main gates on the **south side** of the road or trailers may be able to park **on the point** without a car. You will be able to rig your boats next to your trailer. There will be golf carts to help get your gear to the clubhouse area. Additional cars are asked to park outside the main gate. Cars parked in the wrong areas are subject to being towed.

Food – Our chef will be offering a South Points Menu for our competitors and their guest's downstairs at the Regatta Bar. Burgers, hotdogs, pressed Cubans, and chicken tenders will be available for purchase from 1100 1400. The club will be accepting credit cards, or you can present your member card from a reciprocal club. Unfortunately, we do not accept cash. Please eat downstairs.

Pets - We love animals, but we ask that you leave your pets at home. The Yacht Club does not allow non-member owned pets on site but does welcome service animals.

Viewing Area - Racing will take place directly off the south shore of the clubhouse making it easy to keep up with your sailors. We ask that you set up camp downstairs so that our members have room to eat and relax in the clubhouse and upper deck during the regatta. There is plenty of space to bring your team tents and set up chairs right along the water's edge.

Restrooms – The pool house will be under construction at the time of the regatta. There are air-conditioned port-a-lets available for your use next to the pool. We ask that you wash any sand off your feet/shoes before entering. Please do not enter the clubhouse upstairs to use the restroom.

Jibs – One numbered jib will be provided to each team. Please have your main sail number available at registration.
