### **NOTICE OF RACE**

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with Sarasota Youth Sailing

**1. RULES: 1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the appropriate ISSA Championship Conditions, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

**1.2** All competitors must wear a US Coast Guard Approved Life Jacket at all times when racing.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY/FORMAT**

**2.1.** Competing schools must be current members of ISSA and SAISA and meet eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, and Supplemental Rules.

**2.2.** Registration is on a first paid/first allowed basis. Registration will be confirmed via email, or phone, if email is not available. Please register using the link here: [South Points#3 Registration Link](#).

**2.3.** Junior Varsity teams may be permitted to register at the Host's discretion and must bring their own boat. Such Teams will be scored for the regatta and the League Series in accordance with the Supplemental Rules.

**2.4.** It is the intention of the Race Committee to start JV teams separately.

**2.5.** Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.

**2.6.** This will be a two-division regatta; teams will sail two races as a set, then swap A & B Divisions using the same boat. NO ROUND ROBIN ROTATION. A Sound Signal Starting System shall be used. Time permitting; the Race Committee will run a series of multiple races. It shall be the goal of the race committee to complete as many races as possible considering weather conditions. Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a regatta. All coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment, or sustenance shall be provided only on shore.

### **3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:**

**3.1.** Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting an official entry form and entry fee through Regatta Network to the regatta chairperson by 5pm Weds October 29, 2025.

### **4. ENTRY FEE:**

**4.1.** The entry is \$ 75.00 per each school team, paid in advance via RN. Registration may be found by going to this [link](#). Each school will receive an email with an invoice from Square to pay the registration fee ahead of time. Registrations may be paid at check in via credit card or check made payable to "Sarasota Youth Sailing". Each competitor must have waiver signed. Please email your waiver to [dustin@sarasotayouthsailing.org](mailto:dustin@sarasotayouthsailing.org) or bring a printed copy to check in.

### **5. DAMAGE:**

**5.1.** Damage that requires more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Regatta chairman determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage one or both boats may be disqualified regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, the skipper and crew of one or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and held financially responsible for the damages. Due to varied conditions that may be encountered, and the skill level of individual sailors and teams, it is the advisor &/or coaches' decision to sail and participate and their decision to race.

## **6. BOATS:**

**6.1.** The host will NOT provide any boats

**6.2.** Each team must bring their own boat and equipment, and will sail their own boat in each race. This changes ISSA Procedural Rules 7.4(a), 7.4(b), and 7.6; and SAISA Supplemental Rules 4.5 and 4.6.

## **7. SCHEDULE:**

**7.1** Saturday November 1, 2025

0830 Check-in/Registration Rigging of boats

0915 - Skippers' meeting at the Ken Thompson Park

1000 – Start of first race of the day

**7.2.** Changes to the schedule will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the regatta check-in table in Ken Thompson Park.

## **8. RACING AREA:**

**8.1** All races will be sailed in the Sarasota Bay as close to shore as possible. Rotations will take place in Ken Thompson Park.

## **9. COURSES:**

**9.1** Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR

## **10. SCORING:**

**10.1.** The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

## **12. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:**

### **13. COACHING:**

**13.1.** Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday 0730 to the end of the regatta event unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

### **14. OFFICIAL NOTICE:**

**14.1.** No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(b). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.

### **15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:**

**15.1.** By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

### **16. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:**

**16.1.** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

**16.2.** The race organizers (including the organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each

competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted bylaw.

## **Sarasota Youth Sailing General Programs Waiver 2025**

The goal of Sarasota Youth Sailing, Inc. (SYS) is to provide a safe and educational environment for all participants. It is of utmost importance that all sailors and their parents be aware of the standards expected regarding behavior both on and off the water. Sarasota Youth Sailing wishes to promote mutual respect amongst its sailors, coaches, parents, volunteers, and guests through the use of appropriate language, attitude and behavior.

**Code of Conduct:** All participants, including parents and youths of Sarasota Youth Sailing, agree that:

1. Safety is the top priority.
2. I will demonstrate mutual respect for all sailors, coaches, parents, and volunteers regardless of age, race, gender, religion, national origin or abilities.
3. I will represent SYS with my best efforts, never bringing embarrassment or an unfavorable view to the program.
4. I will respect all equipment and property. I will take personal and financial responsibility for any damage I incur. Parents will take joint responsibility for damage caused by their children.
5. I will respect the Gulf of Mexico, Sarasota Bay, their shores and the creatures that make them their home.
6. I will not verbally and/or physically threaten or abuse any other person.
7. I will refrain from smoking, drinking and/or illegal drug use.
8. I will not bring any weapons to any SYS practice or event.
9. I will not use any social media website or tool to mock, belittle or abuse any sailor, coach or anyone else associated with SYS.
10. I will continually strive to demonstrate good sportsmanship on and off the water. I will follow the fundamental rules of fair sailing.

### **BOAT DAMAGE DISCLAIMER FOR CHARTERED BOATS**

Parents and sailors (regardless of age) are responsible for and agree to pay for boat damage beyond normal wear and tear.

**Photograph and Image Release:** I agree to allow SSS or SYS staff and/or participant parents or other volunteers to photograph myself and/or my child and use in marketing materials and/or website content.

**Medical Release:** In the event of an emergency requiring medical attention for my child, I hereby authorize and consent to any x-ray, examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or procedure rendered under the general or specific supervision of any medical professional licensed under the laws of the State of Florida. I understand that this permission is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment or hospital care being required but is given to provide authority and power to render care which the aforementioned medical personnel in the exercise of their best judgment may deem advisable. I understand that reasonable efforts shall be made to contact the undersigned prior to rendering treatment to the patient, but that any of the above treatments will not be withheld if I cannot be reached.

**Parent's/Participant's Consent and Waiver of Liability-Assumption of Risk-Indemnity Agreement**

As the parent or legal guardian (hereafter referred to in the singular) of the named adult or child in this registration (herein referred to as the "child"), request that the child be allowed to participate in the activities at Sarasota Youth Sailing (SYS) (herein referred to as "the activities"). The agreement shall remain in effect until Sarasota Youth Sailing (SYS) receives written notice of the cancellation of the consent or until the end of the activities described above.

In return for the child or myself being permitted to take part in the activities and to use the facilities, equipment, and property of the Sarasota Sailing Squadron (SSS) and SYS, each of us makes the following promises and warrants the truth of the following facts.

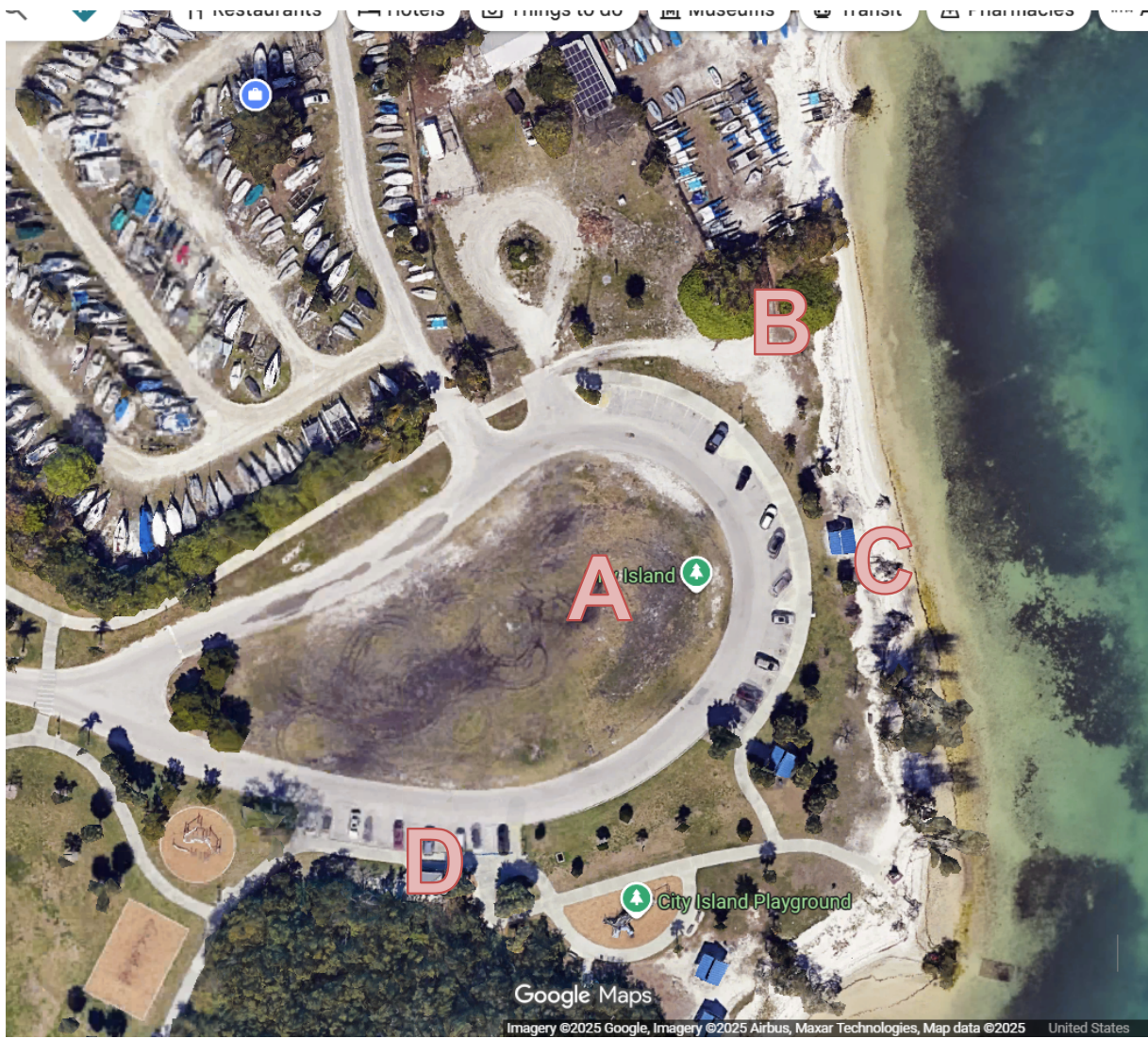
1. Parental consent or consent for myself: I am familiar with the programs included in the activities, and I understand officers and employees of the SYS are available to discuss the activities should I wish additional information. I also understand I or the appointed chaperone is solely responsible for the arrival and departure of my child at the beginning and end of each day's program. I will not allow my child to remain on the premises of the SYS (unless in accordance with SSS policies) after each day's program without providing appropriate supervision or the written permission of the SYS. I agree that the SSS OR SYS will have no responsibility for the supervision of myself or my child at times other than during the scheduled activities. I will inform my child that he/she is expected to cooperate with and follow the directions of the persons in charge of the activities and to act in a manner consistent with the spirit of good sportsmanship and respect for the rights of others.
2. My child is in good health, and I know of no reason why he/she would be incapable of participating in the activities. My child knows how to swim.

**RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY: For and in consideration of full and adequate consideration, We,** on behalf of ourselves and our child, our representatives, agents, heirs, successors and assigns ("Releasors") hereby waive, release, and forever discharges, SYS OR SSS or any of its members, directors, officers, agents, employees and affiliated organizations (herein referred to as "Releasees") from any and all debts, losses, obligations, accounts, claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of action, contribution claims or suits of any kind or nature whatsoever, in law, contract tort or equity including any claims for negligence, now existing or hereafter arising, whether now known or unknown, or hereafter becoming known, accrued or hereafter accruing, which Releasors have or may have, upon any or by any reason or thing whatsoever related to or arising from my or my child's participation in the activities and use of the facilities and property of SYS AND SSS.

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** We are aware that the activities may involve maneuvering a boat, sailboard, or other watercraft with motors and propellers on deep water in potentially hazardous conditions which may include among other things, strong winds, high waves, sudden and unexpected immersion in deep waters and collision with watercrafts or stationary objects such as docks, pilings and buoys. With the knowledge of the dangers involved we, on behalf of ourselves and our child, together with any of our heirs, representatives, successors or assigns, in consideration of our child be allowed to take part in the activities as set forth herein, **HEREBY KNOWINGLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISKS TO MYSELF AND OR MY CHILD FOR ANY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE RELATED TO THE ACTIVITIES ENGAGED IN WITH SSS AND SYS, THEIR, AGENTS MEMBERS, OR OTHER REPRESENTATIVES, WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER ACTION, EXCEPT IN INTENTIONAL ACTS OF ANY OF THE RELEASES.**
