TROPHIES:

1st, 2nd, and 3rd Overall Place in each Class will be awarded based on the number of boats registered. 1st place trophies will be awarded in all classes. 2nd place trophies will be awarded for classes with 3 or more boats registered. 3rd place trophies will be awarded for classes with 5 or more boats registered.

SCORING:

A modified Low-Point Scoring System, Rule A2 will apply except that no race score will be excluded from a competitor's series score. Ties will be broken as provided in Rule A8.

RACING AREA:

The racing area will be in the Bay of St. Louis, generally east of the Bay-Waveland Yacht Club.
