Rules

All races will be governed by the 2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing, the current prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, One Design Class when not in conflict with the forgoing and FYC Sailing Instructions. The 420 Class will be governed by the 2025-2028 Interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) Procedural Rules (PR) unless otherwise specified in the Sailing Instructions.

Safety

All competitors must always wear a USCG-approved life jacket while on the water, except to quickly change clothing. A team uniform or "Pinnie" is encouraged but not required.

Eligibility and Entry

A team is composed of sailors who meet eligibility requirements of ISSA PR Part III, (9th -12th grade). For B Fleet only, ISSA PR 1.2 is modified 7th -12th grade. Each team must designate an adult (who may or may not be the team coach, but who is not a team member or high school student) who is responsible for and must accompany the school's team and remain on site during sailing.

Boats

FYC will provide Club 420s and racing sails, A and B divisions. Boats will be sailed as provided.

Entry Fee

\$100.00 per High School Sailing Team. No damage deposit is required. However, teams remain responsible for the repair cost of any damage caused by any team member. In the event FYC cannot attribute damage to a particular team, it will divide the repair costs evenly among all competing teams.

Racing Area

The racing area will be Mobile Bay in the vicinity of FYC shores.

Scoring

The RC will score the regatta in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules. Competitors will be able to find official scores at scores.hssailing.org. "A" Fleet scores only will seed qualifiers for participation in Great Oaks Regatta.

Races / Courses

Two or more Round Robins are scheduled. Multiple races will be attempted; however, two races completed in A division shall constitute a series / regatta. This changes ISSA PR 7.5 (c).

Coaching- See ISSA PR 8

A competitor may receive coaching or assistance only while on shore or on the dock.

Official Notice

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841. Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during this weekend may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson. This protest committee shall, at a time and place selected by them, meet to hear said protest, and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta, shall be final, without appeal.
