**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES:**

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

**2. ELIGIBILITY:**

- 2.1. Competing schools must be Catholic Schools, members of the ISSA, their respective ISSA district, and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 2.2. Only girls may compete in this regatta.
- 2.3. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.4. Multiple teams from the same school are allowed.

**3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:**

**4. ENTRY FEE**

- 4.1. Entry fee is \$100 per team (boat) entered. Checks must be made payable to Ursuline Academy and mailed to:

**5. BOATS**

- 5.1. Z420s will be provided by Community Sailing New Orleans and must be sailed as provided.
- 5.2. Boats will only be rotated if the weather conditions allow. A decision will be made whether or not to rotate boats at the competitors meeting. Rotations will occur on the water if the decision to rotate is made.
- 5.3. The race committee may require the use of mast floats and/or reduced area sails as provided

**6. Schedule:**

Note the times of items listed in green could change depending on the weather. If a decision is made, communications will be made through text and email to the numbers and emails given on entry form

**Friday, February 2nd**

**Saturday, February 3rd**

8:30am meet at Jackson Square in the French Quarter for beignets

10:00am Report time for racing at Community Sailing Dock on the west entrance to the Municipal Yacht Harbor. Racing as soon as possible after report time

5:00pm Regatta dinner at TBA followed by Mardi Gras Parade

**Sunday, February 4th**

8:30am Catholic mass at regatta venu. Racing to immediately follow

Racing concludes by 2:00pm Awards to follow

**SCORING:**

7.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

**PRIZES:**

8.1. Trophies will be given to teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall

**Coaching:**

9.1 Coaches, spectators, and extra sailors are allowed to go afloat on boats provided by host. [Modifies ISSA PR 8(a)].

**OFFICIAL NOTICE:**

10.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(b). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.

**RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:**

11.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

**WAIVER OF LIABILITY:**

12.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

12.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
